Sundays for ages 0 - 18

During the 9.30am service

A crèche is available in **Church House** every Sunday during the 9.30am service and provides a safe and caring environment for babies and children from **0 - 2 years**.

All children **aged 3 - 14** start by coming into church for a time of worship then go to their own groups except when there is an All Age Service, which is short (45 minutes) and child friendly.

The **Discoverers Group**, for children with special needs, will meet twice each month through the autumn term.

Once a month (to coincide with Holy Communion) all the children meet in the Church Hall for **Fun in the Sun** - for Scramblers through to Trekkers.

Term time during the 6.30pm service

Evening Trekkers (ages 9 - 11) takes place in the Church Hall, looking at the Bible passage that is being used in the 6.30pm service, with activities, drama, videos, songs and time for prayer.

Pathfinders (ages 11 - 13) meet on Sundays from 6.30-7.30pm in Emmanuel Hall. In an action packed hour we have games, skits, songs, time to hang out and learn more about God. This is an ideal time for those who want to invite along their friends.

Youth Fellowship (ages 14 - 18) attends the 6.30pm service and then move to the Waller's house at 7.45pm for small group fellowship. An opportunity to connect with the wider church and with one another while becoming deeper followers of Jesus.
