Sundays for ages 0 - 18

During the 9.30am service

A crèche is available in the **Church Hall (Ministry Centre from March)** every Sunday during the 9.30am service and provides a safe and caring environment for babies and children from **0 - 2 years**.

All children **aged 3 - 14** start by coming into church for a time of worship then go to their own groups except when there is an All Age Service. These services are short (45 minutes) and child friendly.

The **Discoverers Group**, for children with special needs, meets twice each month in the Ministry Centre.

Term time during the 6.30pm service

Pathfinders (ages 11 - 13) meet on Sundays from 6.30 – 7.30pm in Emmanuel Hall. In an action packed hour we have games, skits, songs, time to hang out and learn more about God. This is an ideal time for those who want to invite along their friends.

Youth Fellowship (ages 14 - 18) attends the 6.30pm service and then move to Emmanuel Hall at 7.45pm for small group fellowship. An opportunity to connect with the wider church and one another while becoming deeper followers of Jesus.

Christian FAQs

On Sunday evenings in church from 8 - 9.30pm, looking in more detail at some of the tough questions Christians find themselves (or others) asking. The evenings include teaching, group discussion and time for questions.

Jan 15: **Why and how should Christians care for creation?**

Lent Courses

We will be running two courses during Lent this term, taking place concurrently on Wed evenings 22 Feb, 7 & 21 Mar, and 4 Apr. One course will be called 'Patterns of Prayer', and the second is entitled 'God at Work', which will explore how we can all serve God more effectively in our work, whether that is at home, in an office environment or elsewhere.
