Women of the Bible

What part do women play in the Bible story?

Our Summer sermon series looks in depth at some of the female characters in the Bible and looks at what makes them special and influential in God's mission.

What will emerge is a unique picture of womanhood and its part in salvation history. From Sarah (the mother of all nations) to Martha (the proclaimer of Jesus as Messiah), women altered the course of events in God's strength. This is our chance to understand more of who they were and how God worked through them.

Sundays for ages 0 - 18

During the 9.30am service

A crèche is available in **Church House** every Sunday during the 9.30am service and provides a safe and caring environment for babies and children from **0 - 2 years**. All children **aged 3 - 14** start by coming into church for a time of worship then go to their own groups - **see weekly newsletter for venues** - except when there is an All Age Service, which is short (45 minutes) and child friendly. Once a month (to coincide with Holy Communion) all the children meet in the Church Hall and Church House for Scramblers through to Trekkers.

Term time during the 6.30pm service

Evening Trekkers (ages 9 - 11) takes place in the Church Hall, looking at the Bible passage that is being used in the 6.30pm service, with activities, drama, videos, songs and time for prayer. Trekkers' Eternal takes place on the first Sunday of the month from 5.30-6.30pm with computer games, pool, foosball, snacks, and fun; it's a great place to bring along your friends!

Pathfinders (ages 11 - 13) meet on Sundays from 6.30-7.30pm in Emmanuel Hall. In an action packed hour we have games, skits, songs, time to hang out and learn more about God. This is an ideal time for those who want to invite along their friends.

Youth Fellowship (ages 14 - 18) attends the 6.30pm service and then move to the Waller's house at 7.45pm for small group fellowship. This is an opportunity to connect with the wider church body and with one another while becoming deeper followers of Jesus.
